Cuddle up with the beloved animal friends from the bestselling Steam Train, Dream Train and count on lots of fun! Little train enthusiasts will love counting from one to ten along with the dreamy train cars!

E BAR Barnett, Mac. Rules of the house /

An update of the classic folk song, Old MacDonald, featuring farm vehicles like excavator, dump truck, and bulldozer.

A book with peek-through holes that let a child view the changes in a tree throughout the four seasons.

E HUN Hunter, Anne, Cricket song /

As crickets sing in the breeze, hunting owls watch over the bay, and sea otters doze on the tide, two children on different continents go to bed.

E MIL Miller, Pat, The hole story of the doughnut /

A mother and son use their imagination to have fun on a rainy day.

EM APP Appelt, Kathi, Counting crows /

The reader is invited to count hungry crows as they hunt for savory snacks.

EM ISA Isadora, Rachel, I hear a pickle : (and smell, see, touch, and taste it, too!) /

Children explore their five senses, learning what they can see, smell, hear, touch, and taste.

EM ROS Rosen, Michael, A great big cuddle : poems for the very young /

Invites children to celebrate the sounds and versatility of language, presenting nonsense verses in the style of classic nursery rhymes designed to induce giggles and help children recognize their feelings.

EM SEH Sehgal, Kabir, The wheels on the tuk tuk /

In this twist on the classic song "The Wheels on the Bus," the wheels on the tuk tuk go round and round all over the city in India.

J FIC ALV Alvarez, Julia. Before we were free / Alfred A. Knopf : | Distributed by Random House, 2002

In the early 1960s in the Dominican Republic, twelve-year-old Anita learns that her family is involved in the underground movement to end the bloody rule of the dictator, General Trujillo.

J FIC DES DeStefano, Lauren. A curious tale of the in-between /

Bright, imaginative, eleven-year-old Pram lives with two aunts who run a retirement home, hiding the fact that she can talk with ghosts--but not the spirit of her mother--and after befriending Clarence, who also lost his mother, she decides to find her father in hopes he can answer her questions.

J FIC DIC DiCamillo, Kate. Leroy Ninker saddles up /

The Ghastly McNastys love treasure as much as they hate children. So when the pirates hear that Captain Syd's lost treasure is (definitely, maybe) buried in Little Snoring Castle, where a pirate movie is being filmed, they pose as extras to gain access to the castle...and the treasure. J FIC KIN Kinsey-Warnock, Natalie. As long as there are mountains / Puffin, 2001

Thirteen-year-old Iris dreams of one day running the family farm in northern Vermont, but the summer of 1956 holds many shocking changes that threaten the life Iris loves.

J FIC MES Messner, Kate, The seventh wish /

Unsure of how to get her family's attention, Charlie comes across the surprise of her life one day while ice-fishing...in the form of a floppy, scaly fish offering to grant her a wish in exchange for its freedom.

J FIC OST Ostow, Micol, Louise Trapeze did NOT lose the juggling chickens *probably /
