June 11 – 14: Summer Reading Sign Up Week! Come to the library to pick up your reading log and program schedule. Check out a book (or 5) and get started on your summer reading!

<u>July 18 – 1:30 & 2:30:</u> StarLab: Journey Through the Stars Learn about the constellations of the Milky Way Starfield in the VINS StarLab, a traveling planetarium. This event will take place at the Windsor High School gymnasium. There are two 45-minute sessions, beginning at 1:30 and 2:30. Seating is limited to 25 each session; registration required.
