Read a story about a famous astronaut.



Read a nonfiction (true) book about space with your child.



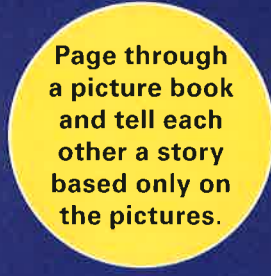
Have your child paint a picture of the night sky or the planets.



Share a story about your childhood.



Page through a picture book and tell each other a story based only on the pictures.



Ask your child what she thinks a spaceship sounds like.



"Adopt" a stuffed animal pet. Talk about how to care for it.



Count with your child as you drive in the car (signs, cars, trucks, etc.).



Read wordless books with your child.



Do fingerplays and action rhymes any time.



Share a book about your favorite animal.

Play an upbeat song and make up a dance together.



Play a board game or card game with your child.



Put a puzzle together with your child.



Talk about the various sounds you hear as you go about your day.



Sing "The Itsy Bitsy Spider" and do motions to match the words.



Go on a sensory walk together. Talk about what you see, hear, feel, and smell.



Go on a shape hunt around the house. How many triangles can your child find?



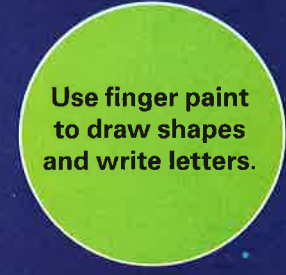
Act out your child's favorite story with stuffed animals.
